STUDENT RESIDENTIAL APPLICATION

Although the Student Village is unsupervised, self catering accommodation, there are certain standards, hygiene requirements, living conditions and rules that must be adhered to:

- Residents who use drugs (unless medically prescribed) may be asked to leave the Village.
- Residents must moderate their use of liquor, and must not be offensive or disorderly.
 Drunken behaviour is not acceptable and may lead to the dismissal of the resident from the Village.
- Sexual, racial or religious harassment will not be tolerated.
- Residents must keep their unit to an acceptable living standard. Dishes must be washed, dried and put away each day. Bins, both inside and outside of the unit must be emptied regularly.
- Residents must keep their bedroom to an acceptable living standard. Rooms must be kept tidy. Rubbish must be removed. Dirty dishes must be removed. Perishable foods are **not** to be kept in the bedroom.
- Candles are prohibited in the Student Village.
- Radiators/fan heaters are prohibited in the Student Village.
- Pets are **not** permitted in the Student Village.

There is a great deal of freedom in the Student Village; however the University expects its residents to choose a balanced lifestyle.

The above matters are for the applicant's information. Applicants who feel that they cannot adhere to any of the above should not proceed with this application.

If accepted as a resident in the University of South Australia Whyalla Campus Student Village, I agree to abide by the Occupancy Agreement, General Rules, Payment requirements, and normal acceptable standards of social behaviour during my period of residency in the Student Village.
