

COMMONWEALTH SCHOLARSHIPS

A range of Commonwealth scholarships are available to assist Indigenous students, particularly from remote and regional areas. Examples include:

Indigenous Commonwealth Accommodation Scholarship Value: A\$5,199 p.a.
Indigenous Commonwealth Education Costs Scholarship Value: A\$2,599 p.a.

INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS

We offer a number of scholarships to international students to support their study and achievements. Examples include:

Vice Chancellor's International Excellence Scholarship Recipients receive a 50% reduction in their student contributions (tuition fees) p.a., for up to four years of full-time study.
International Merit Scholarship Recipients receive a 25% reduction in their student contributions (tuition fees) for the first year of study in their chosen program, up to a maximum of two semesters or eight courses.
UniSA International Scholarship This scholarship is open to international students enrolled full-time in the second year of an undergraduate program and is valued at A\$15,000.

HIGH-ACHIEVING STUDENTS

UniSA is committed to rewarding the success of high-performing students, including current students and those who are new to university, with a range of grants and scholarships.

Examples:

Ian D. McLachlan Memorial Grant	AS5,000 UG HA FN R
Belinda Helen Jefferys Human Resource Management Scholarship	AS5,000 UG HA
UniSA Women in Science Technology Engineering and Mathematics Scholarship	AS15,000 UG HA

STUDENTS IN FINANCIAL NEED

There are a number of scholarships aimed at assisting students in situations of financial disadvantage. These can include assistance with tuition fees, cash grants for textbooks and materials, and more.

Examples:

Cowan Ability Grant	AS1,000 FN UG A
David Pank Undergraduate Scholarship	AS2,000 p.a. – up to AS8,000 FN UG NS

The Finn Family Refugee Study Grant	AS1,500 UG* NS FN

ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER STUDENTS

Some scholarships offer assistance specifically for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students. Many are named in honour of prominent Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people, and are offered by both UniSA and related organisations.

Examples:

Goodes O’Loughlin UniSA GO Scholarship	AS6,000 p.a. – up to AS24,000 UG HA NS C
Gavin Wanganeen Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Scholarship	AS5,000 p.a. – up to AS20,000 UG HA FN NS C
University of South Australia Scholarship for Power Cup participants	AS2,000 p.a. – up to AS8,000 UG FN NS
Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander MBA Scholarship	Full program fee is provided in partnership with industry PG NS

RURAL STUDENTS

Students from rural and isolated areas may be eligible for scholarships to help with the relocation costs of moving to the city to pursue full-time study. There are also a number of grants to support students studying or completing placements in rural and remote areas.

Examples:

Rotary Club of the Barossa Valley Foundation Scholarship	AS3,000 UG HA FN NS
Cowan Regional Grant	AS2,000 UG FN R

PLACEMENT GRANTS

The costs associated with completing a professional placement can be high, so we offer a number of grants to help meet these costs.

Examples:

Cowan Regional Placement Grant	AS1,000 UG FN NS
University of South Australia Placement Grant	AS2,500 UG FN

UniSA ONLINE SCHOLARSHIPS

UniSA Online students may be eligible to apply for relevant study grants. These grants provide financial assistance to full-time and part-time students enrolled in a UniSA Online undergraduate degree, and range in value between AS1,000-AS5,500.
