Language requirements	To participate in the courses taught at the University of Liechtenstein, an upper-intermediate Level B2(+) is required. You can submit an official diploma or certificate. Certificates of attainment are also accepted.
Exams	Exchange students are required to stay until the end of the scheduled exams as mentioned in the academic calendar. Grading system at the University of Liechtenstein. Workload measured in ECTS (European Credit Transfer System) 1 ECTS = 30 working hours
Students with special needs	Should be advised in the nomination email about the special needs, or any different reason that needs special adjustments.
Accommodation	University of Liechtenstein offers residential facilities. As soon as a student is accepted by the University of Liechtenstein, a reservation can be made in our student dormitory
Living and staying	The most frequently asked questions about living and staying in Liechtenstein
Visa Requirements	Students who wish to take up temporary residence in Liechtenstein for the purpose of study need to apply for a short-term residence permit. The coordination center of permits will assist you with the application process. Students from third countries require a visa to enter Liechtenstein. The University of Liechtenstein provides support – students are requested not to start the procedure by themselves. Please contact the university's coordination center for permits bewilligungen@uni.li
Health Insurance	It is compulsory to have a proof of a valid health insurance. Students from non-EU countries must get in contact with bewilligungen@uni.li to organize a valid health insurance for Liechtenstein.
