Study modes

On-campus/online

Students may complete their studies through a blend of on-campus and online study. Some degrees are also offered online, however students may be required to attend on-campus workshops and assessments.

On-campus

Students will attend on-campus lectures, tutorials, practicals, workshops or seminars; some courses may be able to be completed online.

100% online

All learning and assessments are fully online.

Selection Rank

For Year 12 applicants, your Selection Rank is your ATAR score including any adjustment factors you are eligible for. The Selection Rank is used to determine your competitiveness relative to other applicants.

Adjustment Factors

Guaranteed Entry

UniSA offers Guaranteed Entry into many degrees. Closing date for applications to avoid the SATAC late fee.

Equal consideration closing date for undergraduate applications (SATAC late fees may apply).

18 December:

Change of preference deadline for early December offers.

20 December:

Early December offer round (all preferences).

6 January:

Response deadline for early December offer round.

10 January:

Main January offer round.

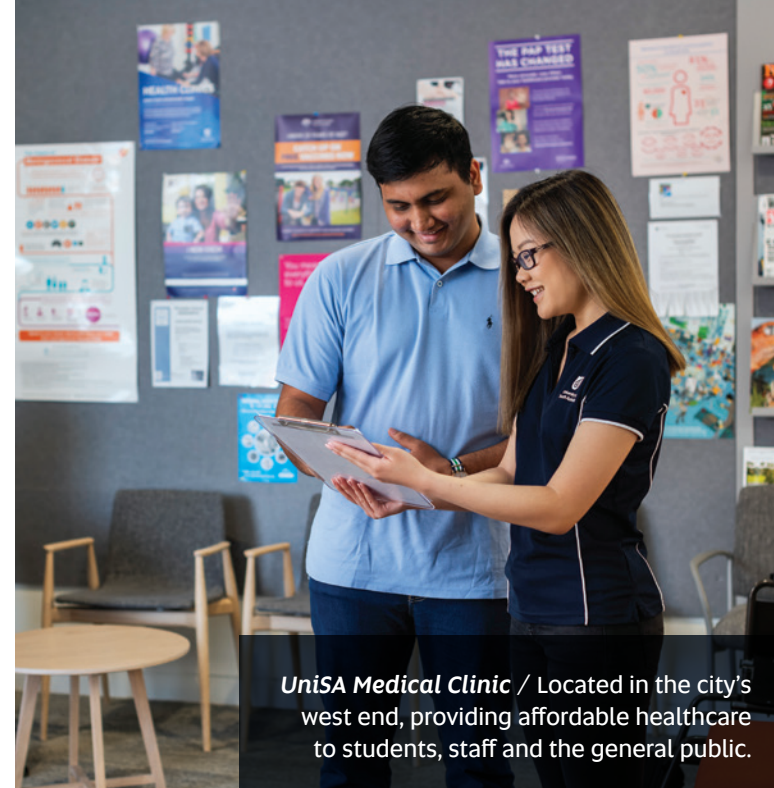

Pridham Hall / This is our new heart and where you will graduate. It also has open social spaces, sporting facilities and a swimming pool.



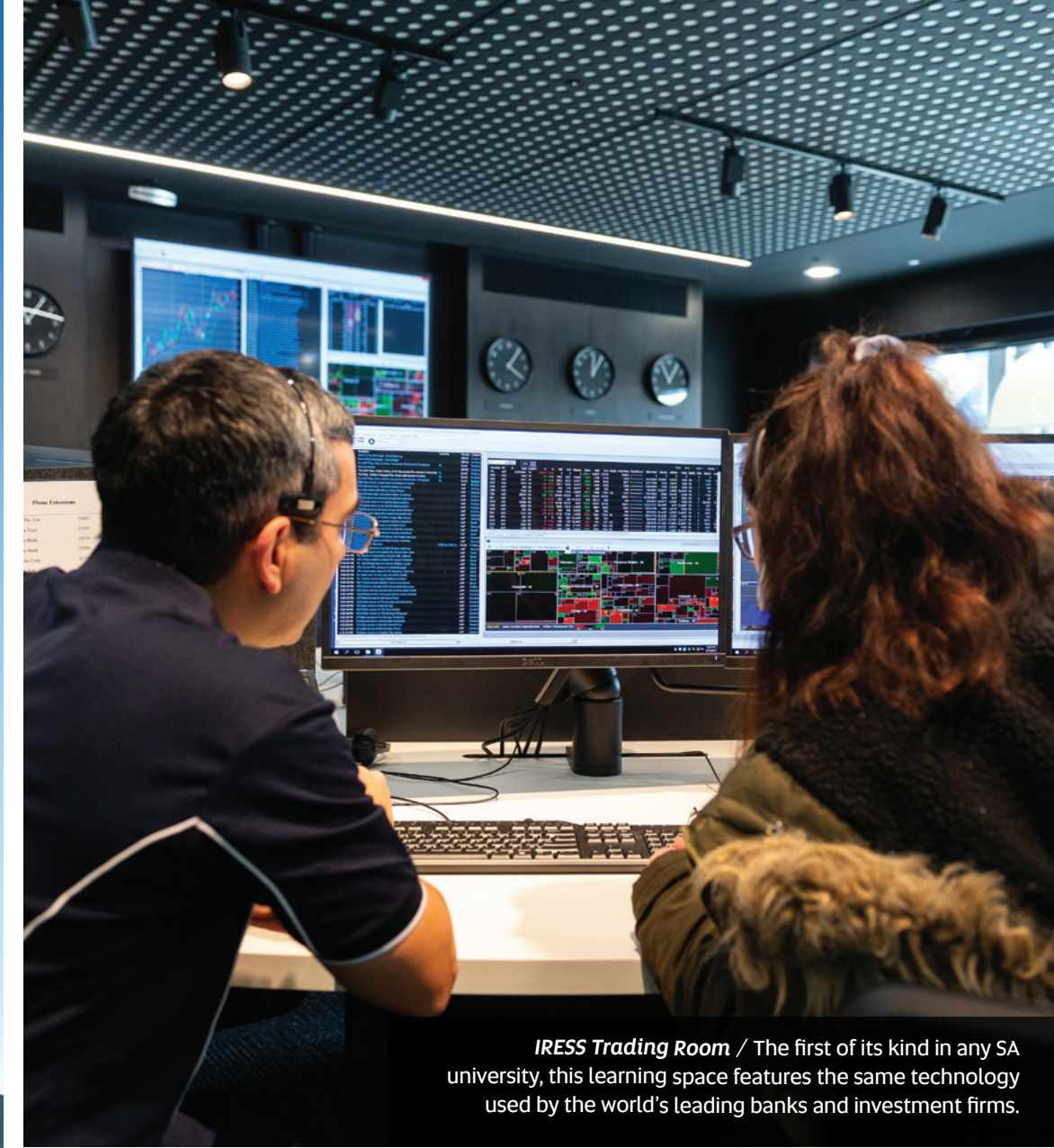
