**MILNE, F. Kenneth**

F. Kenneth Milne (18/07/1885–3/10/1980) was one of South Australia's most well-known, prolific and popular early- to mid-twentieth century architects. He resisted modernism and remained a devotee of the Georgian style throughout his life.

After attending Glenelg Public School for his primary education and North Adelaide Public School for his secondary schooling, Milne received private finishing tuition. He began his architectural career around 1900 when he was articled to Alfred Wells. He then worked as a draftsman for Wells until 1906 when, against Wells' advice, he moved to Sydney to seek architectural experience, working as a draftsman for Robertson & Marks.

When Milne returned to Adelaide in April 1909 and established his own practice, two of his first commissions influenced his early career. The Hampshire Hotel in Grote Street (1910) led the South Australian Brewing Co. Ltd to commission hotels in both metropolitan and rural areas, and the Adelaide Oval Scoreboard (1911) was so revered that the South Australian Cricket Association became a longstanding client. Over time, Milne established a reputation for domestic architecture and he designed many large residences for wealthy members of Adelaide's establishment. However, he also undertook charitable work and at the outbreak of World War One was an honorary architect for the Red Cross (S.A. Division), a role that continued into the post-war years.

In 1912 Milne took on John Richard Schomburgk Evans as his first articled pupil. Evans completed his articles in 1915 but then enlisted to fight in World War One. He returned to Adelaide in 1920 and became Milne's first partner, the practice becoming F. Kenneth Milne and Evans. Milne's second articled pupil, Charles Alexander Russell, became a partner in 1925. After the partnership was terminated, Milne operated as a sole practitioner from 1931 until 1946. Over the following decades other partners joined Milne, including Rolfe V. Boehm (1946), Lindsay C. Dawkins (1946), Russell S. Ellis (c.1947), F.P. Bulbeck (c.mid-1950s) and John Twopeny (1960).

Milne's significant Adelaide buildings include Lister House (North Terrace, 1927) and the Norwich Union Fire Insurance Society Building (Waymouth Street, 1928). Travels in Britain and Europe in 1933 awakened a keen interest in Georgian architecture, particularly the work of Robert and James Adam, and this influence can be seen in his designs for Arbury Park (c.1930s) and his own house, Sunnyside, in North Adelaide (1936).

Other important buildings include Goldsbrough House (North Terrace, 1935) and the H.C. Sleigh building (Pirie Street, 1950s). While its Georgian style was criticised, the Sleigh building illustrates a significant transition point in the state's architectural history when traditional Classical designs were still considered relevant by some architects even in the face of modernism. Reluctant to embrace modernism, Milne gradually retired from practice during the period from 1956 to 1962.

Milne played an active role in the profession: he was President of the South Australian Institute of Architects (SAIA) from August 1937 to August 1939; a founding member of the Architects' Board of South Australia which administered the *Architects' Act* governing the registration of architects; and helped establish the Chair of Architecture at the University of Adelaide and was

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a member of the Faculty of Town Planning and Architecture. This association with the University was reinforced when he established the Kenneth and Hazel Milne Travelling Scholarship in Architecture for architecture students. His contribution to architecture was recognised during his lifetime: the first SAIA Award of Merit for Domestic Architecture for Sunnyside (1944), Her Majesty's Coronation Medal (1953) and Life Fellow of the Royal Australian Institute of Architects (1970).

Notes to Milne Collection

On plans;

- Oldest plan is copy of one of Marble Hill, the now ruined Vice-Regal residence.
- Plans dated 1921, '22, '23 seem to be drawn by Milne himself; most are drawn by other members of the firm.
- Some of the earlier plans are hand-tinted by Milne.
- Job numbers do not always indicate sequence of jobs over time
- Item numbers do not always indicate any particular order, since all the plans were received in a jumble owing to numerous moves of the records.
- Plans are mostly for well-to-do people or larger firms.
- Plans originally came in large brown envelopes with a number on the front as well as the name of the client. This number is reflected on the card index.

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- Materials (i.e., media) in the collection vary and include plain newspaper, tracing and tissue paper, linen, butter paper, cartridge paper, ozalids and blueprints.
- Some plans are in very poor condition; some had to be buffered due to acidic properties or sticky adhesives. Many remain folded and creased.

“Life of Sir William Milne. Refer to article in ‘Home and Gardens’, 1947.

Born in Glasgow in 1822, he came to Australia in the same ship as Mr & Mrs John Disher & their family, when 17 yrs of age. In 1841 he married Eliza Disher the eldest of the family. Eliza, Maggie, Robert (eldest son), William, James, John & Aleck, were the John Disher's family, & all born in Scotland. Mr George Melrose, Mr John Brodie Spense Bank Manager were also on the same ship.

During the time of his arrival, he went into the pastoral areas, his name figures in a block taken up East of Terowie – 140 miles north of Adel. He was married when 19, & his wife Eliza Disher was 21, at Holy Trinity Church of England, North Terrace, the only protestant church & the 1<sup>st</sup> in Adelaide. As far as some of the family remember 2 daughters Eliza & Ellen were born in SA & after they went to Tasmania where Margaret the 3<sup>rd</sup> daughter was born. When he went to Tasmania, there was a British Regiment stationed there, & it was a convict colony, & most of the roads were made by the convicts chained together, this so worked on his wife's feelings, she got him to give it up & come back to SA. He was in the Commerissariat [Commissariat] Dept in connection with the Regt while there. They were only there about 4 years when they returned to SA.

James Disher – his wife's brother wrote to him, while in Tasmania telling him of the business of Patrick Auld for sale. It was a wine & spirit business which he had to give up on a/c of ill-health & only lived 2 or 3 yrs after selling. Mr James Disher was in partnership with William Milne for only 2 or 3 yrs, he never liked it, so gave it up & afterwards took up teaching at Woodside, & was there for many years, educating most of the Disher family & most of the Woodside & Loberthal Districts.

After W. M. returned to SA he went to live in Kermodie St north of the Torrens, & while there William Milne (Jr) their eldest son was born. During their residence at Kermodie St, when Margaret was between 2 & 3 yrs old, all Montifore Hill was scrub in those days, she wandered away with a shepherd boy & his sheep in the morning & her poor mother was in such a state, she had every waterhole dragged in case she'd been drowned. But she came home at evening time safe & sound with the shepherd.

Soon after this he purchased ‘Sunnyside’ from C. B. Newenham [owner of ‘Springfield’] & took his family to live there. As his family increased – the last 7 were born there – Mary who died at 19. Barbara, John, George – James (died at 6 mths teething) Florence & Maud, The family consisting of 11 children.

As his family increased, W. M. threw out the 2 main wings, & put another story to the home, & while the workmen were doing it, his wife was sure they weren't putting the foundations deep enough & spoke to her husband about it. He investigated the matter & found she was quite correct & made the men pull them all up & put deeper. When W. M. went into Parliament in 1857, he gave up his wine & spirit business.

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Dates & births of all the 11 can be got from the Presbyterian Church in Wakefield St, Rev Mr Haining baptised them all as far as the youngest daughter can remember.

They do not know to whom he sold his business, but many years later when his 3 sons were old enough, he established Milne & Coy, Wine & Spirit Merchants, as we know it today. (At one stage he made money & was 1 of the directors for many years in the original Moonta & Wallaroo Mine & also the Burra Mines.)

William Milne (Jr) being the head & carried on until he retired, when Geo. Took over the management. John was not satisfied & wished to become a Brewer, so his Father sent him to Primrose & coy, where he was taught the business from A-Z, he then wished to start on his own, & his Father bought him a Brewery in West Maitland N.S.W, where he stayed for a few years. He was married to Lucy McGeorge when he was 21, & she 17 & had 11 children George married Nellie Swindon & had 3 children, twin sons who later carried on the business (& 1 daughter) being made partners when they were 21. John had 11 children, Lance John, George Hugh, Ken Malcolm, Mary & Edith, 2 sons & 1 daughter died in infancy.

William (Jr) married Emmie Simpson, but there were no children of the marriage. All the Milne girls married in Rotation. Barbara was married in 1879, & then the parents took Florence & Maud for a trip to India Italy, England & Scotland & were to be away 2 years, but Lady Milne (for her husband had been knighted for his work for his country) contracted bronchitis in Scotland & the Dr ordered them back to sunny SA. He was knighted when Pres. Of the Legislative Council, an office he held for 9 years, & during his Parliamentary Career held every portfolio, finishing up with Pres. of Legislative Council. At Sir W. M's death in 1895 his widow didn't require 2 big homes, so sold 'Sunnyside' & kept 'Yurilla' a house he had built near the summit of Mt Lofty between 1884-88.
