The UniSA Tax Clinic provides accessible tax services to unrepresented members of the community seeking assistance with their tax affairs.

The Clinic is a friendly, student-run service providing free advice from UniSA undergraduate and postgraduate taxation students under the supervision of qualified tax professionals.

Client information and enquiries are treated as completely confidential.

We offer appointments in person at our City West campus, over the phone or online via videoconference. Services are open to individual and small business taxpayers without a tax agent.

TEACHING & LEARNING

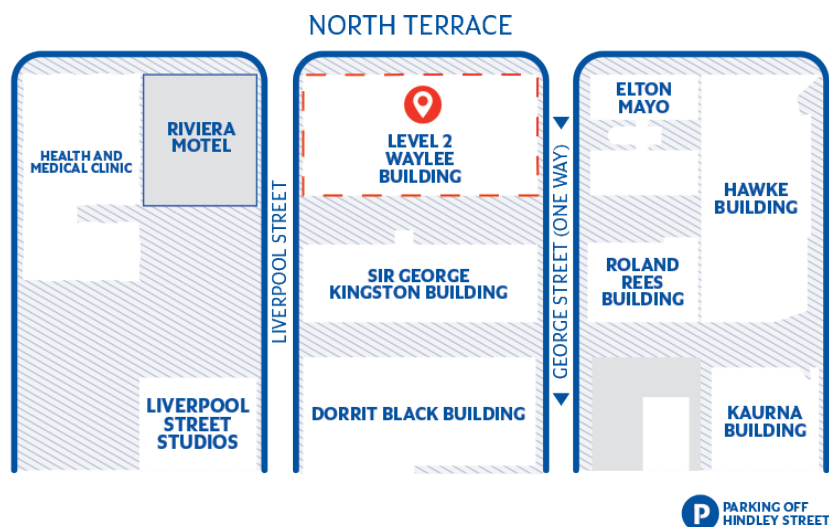
