- 3. Monitor the University's compliance with the *Higher Education Standards Framework (Threshold Standards) 2015* as it relates to research;
- 4. Promote and provide advice on research training, in coordination with Research Degrees Committee;
- 5. Identify, advise on, and monitor matters relevant to research integrity both within and beyond the University;
- 6. Facilitate and strengthen the link between teaching and research.
