### What is the mix of disciplines so far?

Student registrations are pushing past 140 and experience shows that this will only increase as the event gets closer and our promotional activities increase. We also experience a >60% show rate which is somewhat rare among student events, and the current mix of disciplines is fairly reflective of the internship program:

## November cohort Project Briefs – when to submit?

As per the [Key Dates for the Program](#), we are aiming to have Project Briefs submitted by a day ahead of the networking event. This is due to two reasons:

1. Helps ensure you have a plan for the type(s) of opportunities you are seeking to fill, and that it would be suitable within the requirements of the internship program.
2. We advertise opportunities the following week and about half the November cohort won't be able to attend the networking event – so maximises the likelihood of your opportunity being filled.

It's a tight turnaround which unfortunately can't be helped. We schedule these two activities into the 2 week long mid-semester break so as to keep disruption to current courses to a minimum.

The same approach happened for our April event and worked fairly well. Any opportunities that were filled through the networking event were simply withdrawn from advertising.

## Networking Event – How will it work?

The key points:

- **You will be talking for 2 solid hours** – Unlike your usual careers expo, it's students who are grouped at tables by discipline and industry will be working the room for a continuous stream of 5-minute interactions.
- **Why a morning event?** – For 2 simple reasons, there's more energy, and you can attend the event then get on with the rest of your day rather than having to forgo your evening for an after-work function.
- **What disciplines will I engage with?** – You select up to 4 disciplines during the registration process, we do our best to connect you with as many students as possible from those groups.
- **How will I follow up with students?** – There will be a post-event survey where you indicate the students you are keen on. They will do the same and we then confirm any matches so you can continue a dialogue.
- **When are the students looking to do a placement?** – We're prioritising students seeking to undertake placements in our November 2021 and March 2022 cohorts, there will be others there as well.
- **Can I bring colleagues?** – Yes. We're currently inviting industry partners to bring multiple personnel, if we hit capacity we'll reassess at that point.
