

Providing the below information IN FULL at the time you lodge your student visa application will assist the Department of Home Affairs (HA) in processing your application faster. If the Department request any further information from you, please ensure you respond promptly to avoid any delays.

For Streamlined Applicants (AL1) over 18

Completed Form and Payment	All relevant questions of the form 157A or eVisa application must be complete in order for your application to be valid. Your payment must be received and funds cleared in full. Ensure you provide a <u>clear statement</u> explaining your reasons for undertaking your intended course in Australia and address each of the 5 points listed	YES / NO / N/A
Passport	You must provide a copy of the front photograph and details page of the current passport for all applicants included in your application	YES / NO / N/A
Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE)	You must provide a valid CoE (for paper applications) or eCoE (for eVisa application)	YES / NO / N/A
Health Requirements / Medicals My Health Declarations – Electronic health examinations for visa processing	You must meet the government health requirements and may need to complete a health examination – please refer to http://www.immi.gov.au/allforms/pdf/1163i.pdf (Note that examination results are valid for 12 months) To avoid delays, you may be eligible to complete your health examinations before lodging your visa application by using the online system - My Health Declarations	YES / NO / N/A
Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC)	It is a requirement to have Overseas Student Health Cover while in Australia on a Student Visa. Your OSHC must cover the <u>entire</u> length of your stay in Australia on a student visa (and include and accompanying family members). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If your CoE finishes in November / December OSHC is required until 15 March the following year • If your CoE finishes at any other time in the year OSHC is required for 2 months after the CoE end date • If you are a PhD student you must provide OSHC that expires 8 or 9 months after your CoE For further information on OSHC please see: http://www.studyinaustralia.gov.au/en/Study-Costs/OSHC/Overseas-student-health-cover	YES / NO / N/A
Signed Declarations	The ‘financial declaration’ must be complete and ‘Australian values declaration’ of the paper form 157A MUST be signed by all applicants in order for your application to be finalised	YES / NO / N/A
Family Members	Family members (spouse, dependants) are only eligible to accompany you to Australia if your course is at least 12 months duration. You must provide proof of your relationship if this is your first visa together (marriage / birth certificate) You must declare all family members on your application (even if they will not travel with you to Australia on this visa)	YES / NO / N/A
Other Requirements	There may be other documentation you are required to provide or further requirements you need to meet depending on your country of citizenship.
