## PHYSIOTHERAPY FOR CHILDREN

Children can be booked in for 5-week blocks and progress is reviewed at the end of each block to assess the need for further sessions.

Please note there may be a wait list for services. Children who are not already receiving services from a physiotherapist will be given priority.

### Individual Children’s Physiotherapy Service

We offer individual physiotherapy sessions to support the development of children of all ages at an affordable price.

Located at the UniSA City West Health & Medical Clinic, we offer a comprehensive service to improve areas such as movement skills, balance, strength, flexibility, coordination and play/sport skills. We work together with children and families to target specific goals over a 5 week block.

### Motor to the Max

We also offer a free group-based program, Motor to the Max, for preschool and primary school aged children (e.g. 4–8 year olds).

Located at the UniSA Magill campus, children who experience difficulty with movement skills such as balance, coordination, jumping and ball skills, can participate in a small one-hour group session over a 5 week block.

## PODIATRY FOR CHILDREN

The UniSA Podiatry Clinic understands children have their own unique development concerns. Lower limb assessment may assist in early identification, particularly if your child is experiencing pain and activity limitations, or if you have a family history of foot and leg problems.

Located at both the UniSA City East and Magill campuses, we are able to assist with concerns including flat feet, ‘pigeon toed’ walking, Metatarsus adductus, foot orthoses, warts, pains, bow legs and ingrown toenails.

Services are delivered by undergraduate students and supervised by registered physiotherapists and podiatrists.

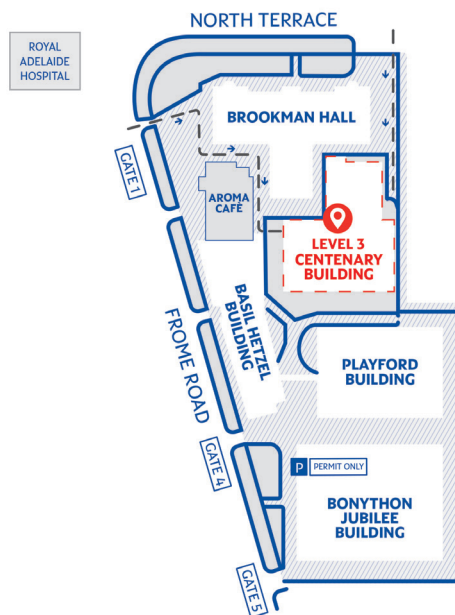

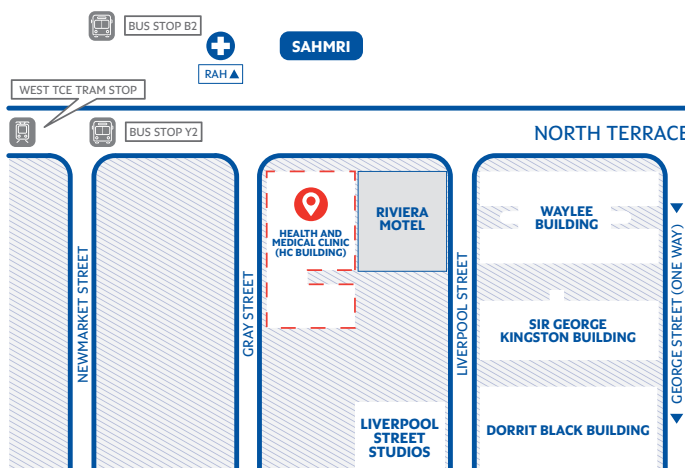
