On Tuesday 4th January 2022, the University will re-open for business as usual for all our teaching and research activities and with all applicable physical distancing and Covid-19 management protocols in place.

In that regard, where you can conduct your duties from home and have the formal approval of your line manager to do so (and have completed the necessary documentation) and where you then choose to do so, you will be able to work remotely.
